We're reinventing the patient experience with a first-in-Canada portable MRI that fast-tracks treatment.



It's being called a game-changer. St. Michael's is the first hospital in Canada to acquire a portable Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) scanner, which can take images of the brain right at the patient's bedside. That reduces the number of times a patient has to be transported to a separate medical imaging department, meaning fewer delays and less stress to the body. It's HUMANCARE in action. "It's all about providing the best care – when, where and how our patients need it," says Dr. Julian Spears, St. Michael's Head of Neurosurgery.




We're reinventing the patient experience by exporting our AI innovations to hospitals around the world.

We're reinventing the patient experience by making brain surgery personal.



May is Brain Tumour Awareness Month, so we decided to ask Dr. Das about his work. We particularly wanted to know about a procedure called "awake craniotomies," where patients remain up and alert, so surgeons can monitor brain activity and preserve brain function.


